PSA-PBK scholarships

PSA-PBK has three scholarship programs for undergraduate and graduate students at the University of Puget Sound (UPS) and the University of Washington (UW). We are pleased to announce the 2021–2022 awardees.

The students who received the **Undergraduate Scholarships** of \$2,000 each are:

- Allie Chapman, UPS; Chinese
- Liana Greger, UPS; Vocal performance
- Delaney Mitchell, UPS; Mathematics

Applicants meet GPA and financial need requirements, and write an essay on the question "What book has influenced your college career most, and why?"

The **Myra Lupton Scholarship**, \$3,400 in 2021, is awarded to a first-generation student at UW or UPS. "First-generation" is defined as having parents or guardians who have not received an associate's or bachelor's degree. We thank Susan Lupton for her generous support. The essay topic for this year was "How has your experience as a first-generation student informed your goals and aspirations for college and beyond?" The scholarship was awarded to Joshua Davis, psychology major at the UW.

Applications for the **Ernest R. Stiefel Graduate Study Award** of \$4,500 are due on November 30. Applicants must be members of Phi Beta Kappa elected at UW or UPS and be in their first year of graduate or professional work at either school. We request a personal letter detailing their educational and career goals, work experience, and any significant personal adversity, economic issues, or disability. The scholarship committee ranks applicants on the social utility of their goals and financial need. Information and the application form are available at https://www.psa-pbk.org/scholarships.

High School Book Awards
